## TASK/MESSAGE: (Did you do tell me about a past vacation.)

- 5 Many details, Concise and varied; Goes beyond the requirements
- 4 The message is clear and comprehensible with sufficient details
- 3 The message has minimum details; the message is mostly comprehensible, minimum of requirements is met.
- 2 The message has basic details only; part or all of the message is unclear, several missing requirements and repetitive
- 1 The message has few to no details; is frequently unclear, most requirements are missing.

## PRESENTATION: (How well did you organize your story)

- 5 Story idea is well developed/organized; ideas are in logical sequence, introduction and conclusion are integrated into the story.
- 4 Story is developed/organized, ideas are in logical sequence. Intro and conclusion present.
- 3 Some parts are adequately arranged or developed. Intro or conclusion missing.
- 2 Paragraphing is inappropriate; ideas are poorly developed and not clear
- 1 Paragraphing is inappropriate and unclear; ideas remain undeveloped

## ACCURACY (grammar (use of preterit), spelling, punctuation):

- 5 Grammar and spelling almost error free, has punctuation (accents) where needed
- 4 Occasional mistakes, most punctuation correct
- 3 Some language mistakes and some repetition
- 2 Mistakes impede intelligibility - use of internet translator is evident
- 1 Numerous errors impede understanding

## VOCABULARY: (what words did you use to describe your vacation)

- 5 Wide and varied range; variety of new words (words not from our vocabulary lists)
- 4 Rich and varied; some use of new words
- 3 Adequate range and variety (what you should know), little repetition
- 2 Barely adequate and/or repetitive
- 1 Limited and often inadequate

## REQUIREMENTS:

4 - 5 **paragraphs** with sufficient information to tell about a previous Spring Break vacation. It should have an **introduction** (tell me the basic details of your vacation), a **body** (2-3 paragraphs) with **details** of specific events during your vacation and a **conclusion** (tell me your opinion of the vacation). Verbs should be in the ***preterit (past) tense.***

## ***Submit typed and double spaced***

Final Story Due Friday 3/19 (or next class if your period doesn't meet that day). 3 points lost for each class period story it is late.

After grading a rewrite for improvement is optional. Both will be graded and the best grade will be used.
